

THE NETWORK OF MEDITERRANEAN ARBITRATION CENTRES

The activity of the Network starts from the independence of the Centre itself and of all the collaborators working inside it, as well as from the independence and impartiality to be required to the arbitrators.

This work will be shaped in a joint paper elaborated by the representatives of the ADR Mediterranean Centres, explaining, through examples and practices, the values and principles related to a fair and efficient administration of an arbitral procedure. The document, a work in progress, will consist of a review to share some basic rules contained in the regulations of each institution.

Any regulation provides, in fact, provisions for the administration of the arbitral procedure that is entrusted to the institution; it is mainly addressed to lawyers and arbitrators. In the shared comment, both the rule as well as the ratio/value below it is expressed: the ratio/value, equal for all, will be explained in language accessible also to those, not jurists, who want to be reassured about the way in which the arbitral institution is committed in managing its own activities in the service of the parties.

It's a new message for content and language, which becomes an annex to each Regulation. The shared comment is intended to be advertised

within the European companies of the South-Mediterranean and will be periodically updated by the working group to maintain the necessary adhesion to the arbitration practice.

A PRIVATE "RIGHT" PROCEDURE AVAILABLE TO ENTREPRENEURS OPERATING IN THE MEDITERRANEAN, IS A SERVICE OFFERED BY SEVERAL ADR CENTRES ONLY, WHICH SHARE HIGH QUALITY STANDARDS.

THE ADVANTAGES OF THIS PROJECT ARE:

geographical proximity to the parties: more arbitration centres located in the MENA region are by definition open to entrepreneurs, lawyers, judges, witnesses;

independence and impartiality: different arbitration centres would provide the parties with more opportunities to choose a "third" centre with respect to the nationality of the parties themselves;

lower economic burden: the economic requirements for the implementation of this project are significantly lower than those of any other project which envisages the creation of new bodies / institutions and consequently also the costs for companies will be more competitive.
